Annex. Illustration on type of indicators and data to be collected for one education model – Early Childhood Development (ECD)

Objective: to improve the ECD outcomes and the school readiness of disadvantaged Roma children aged 0-6, by facilitating and expanding the access to quality ECD services and improving the parenting skills of the Roma parents.

Indicators (on the level of objective)

- Increased enrolment rates of Roma children aged 3-6 in mainstream kindergartens/preschools in the project locality/ies
- Increased enrolment rates of Roma children aged 0-3 in crèches (formal /informal ECD services) in the project locality/ies
- Improved parenting practices among the targeted Roma as measured by increased frequency of parent-children interaction
- Share of children with improved ECD skills as measured by ECD diagnostic tools
- Share and number of Roma children aged 6 enrolled to mainstream, non-segregated, non-special schools/ classes in primary education after ECD services

COMPONENT 1: IMPROVING THE ACCESS TO AND PARTICIPATION IN MAINSTREAM ECD SERVICES

Component indicators:

- Share of Roma children aged 3-6 first time enrolled in non-segregated kindergarten/preschool in the total number of children outreached
- Share of Roma children aged 3-6 in project localities who have completed at least 2 years of preschool and ECD program.
- Share of Roma children aged 3-6, beneficiaries of the project who dropped-out pre-school education during the project implementation.
- Improved ECD outcomes among the targeted young Roma children as measured by the ECD diagnostic tool before and after implementation (if applicable)
- Share of Roma children aged 3-6 in project localities in preschool education with at least 75% monthly attendance
- Number and share of Roma children of age for primary education who enroll 1st grade

Activity outputs (data that will be collected by local implementing partners)

- Number of mediators trained
- Number of mediators recruited
- Number of identity documents issued with the help of the project
- Number of Romani children vaccinated
- Number of households visited
- Number of children identified in age group 0-6
- Number of Roma children enrolled to kindergartens
- Number of Roma children enrolled to preschools
- Number and share of Roma children aged 6 (please specify the country specific primary enrolment age) enrolled in mainstream non-segregated primary schools after preschool completion



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
